


SIMMONS COLLEGE
PETERBOROUGH STREET HOUSES



The Peterborough Street Houses comprise six units, each of which follows the plan above.

The front of the houses (Rooms 1, 2, 5, 6) faces north.

For the year 1930-31 the houses at 22-32 Peterborough Street, Boston, are to be reserved for the use of college graduates and certain other mature students. Students will be subject to the following dormitory rules:

1. A student who is to be out after 10:30 in the evening shall register to that effect.
2. Students shall be in the house by 12:00 at night.
3. It is expected that reasonable quiet will be maintained in the house during the usual hours of study.
4. Smoking is not permitted in the dormitories. This rule applies both to students and to visitors.
5. Visitors are expected to leave by 10:30 in the evening.

The charge for residence for the regular college year for a room occupied by one student is \$525 for the larger rooms, Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5, 7, and 8, and \$475 for the smaller rooms, Nos. 2 and 6. This includes meals, excepting luncheons on days when College is in session. The larger rooms may be occupied by two students, and if two students occupy such a room the charge for each is \$450. *If no preference is indicated, applicants are assigned to double rooms.* In all cases one-half of the annual charge is payable at the beginning of the college year and one-half at the beginning of the second term, in January. In case of withdrawal during the college year, the charge for residence is one-thirtieth of the annual rate for each week or fraction of a week of residence from the beginning of the college year to the date when the formal notice of withdrawal is received by the Dean. Any balance is returned to the student. During the Christmas and spring recesses the Peterborough Street Houses are closed, and students who wish to stay at the College move to South Hall in the main dormitory group, where they are charged at the rate of \$2 a day.

In order to reserve a place in this house a deposit of \$25.00 is required at the time of application. Checks should be made payable to Simmons College, and application for reservations should in all cases be made direct to the Registrar of Simmons College, 300 The Fenway, Boston. The deposit of \$25.00 is deducted from the first term bill. If a student withdraws her application for a room before July 15, the entire amount of the advance deposit is returned. The sum of twenty dollars is returned to a student who withdraws her application after July 15, provided the place reserved for her is filled on or before the opening day of College. If it is not filled no refund is made. Unless a room is occupied, it is not reserved beyond the second week of the college year, except by special agreement. *It is to be understood that rooms are engaged for the college year, unless the student withdraws from the College.*

The College provides one pair of blankets and the necessary furniture for all rooms, but does not include rugs or bookcases. Rugs should not exceed 4½ feet by 7½ feet in size. The bed is a single couch, 36 inches wide; pillows are 22 inches wide. The student supplies towels and all her bed-linen, with the couch cover and extra blankets. The bed-linen is included in the student's personal laundry, for which she makes her own arrangements. Students are expected to care for their own rooms.

Students in the Prince School and the School of Social Work should make allowance for carfares, as the Peterborough Street Houses are at some distance from those Schools.
