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ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW

- Justice is Global is a project of People’s Action, which seeks primarily to build power for disenfranchised communities in the U.S.
- JIG is focused on taking action for the goal of global justice, namely an equitable and sustainable global economy through the reframing of nationalist views
- One major focus is climate justice

ACTIVITIES

- Diffusion of ideas across groups of varying power e.g. MoC, small and large interest groups, friends and family
- Sustainable outcomes if bill is passed or at least attention is raised broadly

ORGANIZING AND ADVOCACY

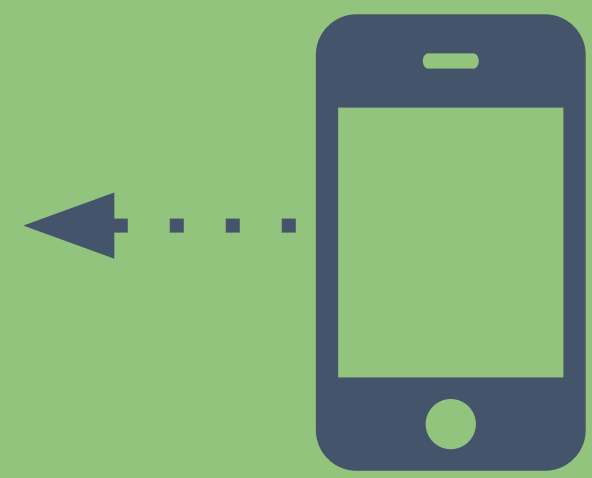
- JIG builds on tradition through grassroots base building and training

CONCLUSION

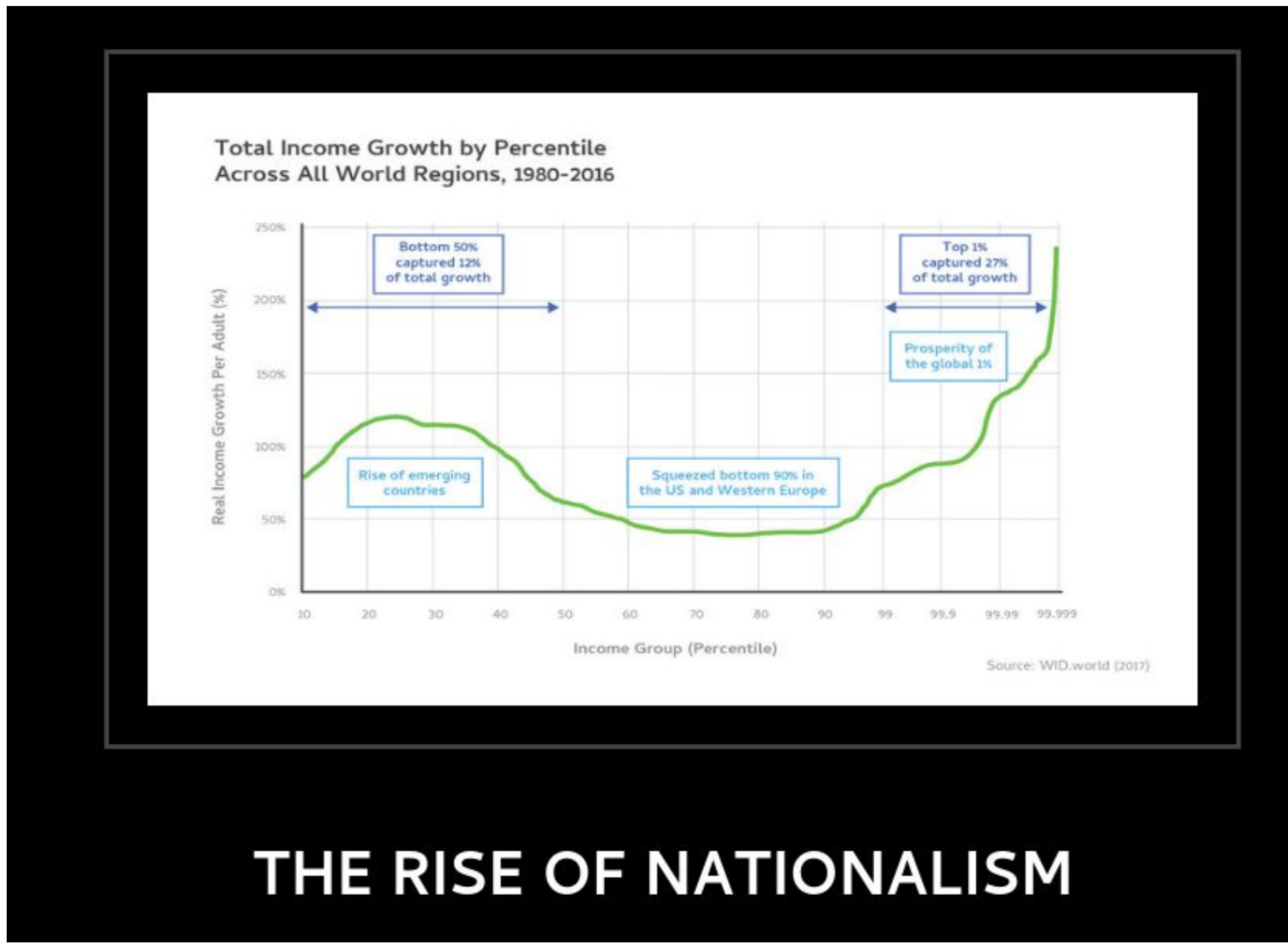
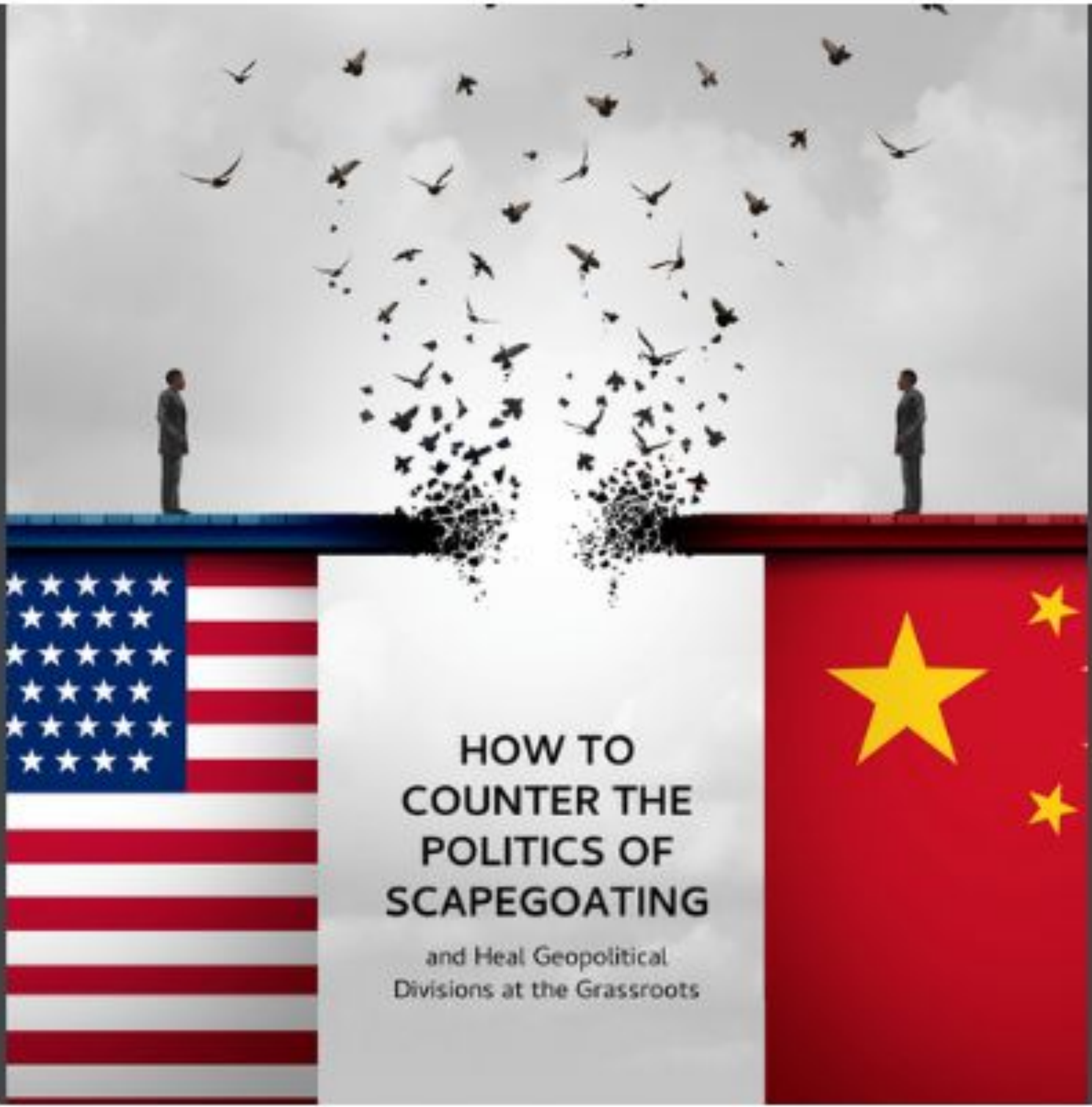
- Successful, incremental change building power of communities to pressure people in power to levy structural reform
